

Classes open to any breed, unless otherwise specified. **Foreign Breed** – any breed that is non-indigenous to the British Isles (partbreds to be a minimum of 25% foreign breed).

#### **OUTDOOR COVERED ARENA**

##### **Sport Horse classes – 8.30am start**

*These 3 classes are open to ANY breed and are restricted to 10 entries per class. Advance entries ONLY for dressage classes – times will be posted on the USA-UK website by 30<sup>th</sup> April.*

#### **INDOOR ASHFORD ARENA**

##### **IN HAND CLASSES – 9am start**

*Classes 1 – 8 open to Purebreds only. Classes 1, 2 & 3 will be judged together but pinned separately*

**1. Morgans** – Mares & Fillies, any age.

**2. Morgans** – Geldings, any age.

**3. Morgans** – Stallions & Colts, any age

*Classes 4, 5 & 6 will be judged together but pinned separately*

**4. Saddlebreds** – 3 years & under

**5. Saddlebreds** – 4 years & over

**6. Saddlebreds** – British Bred

**7. Appaloosas** – any age.

**8. Spanish & Lusitano** – any age

*Classes 9, 10 & 11 & will be judged together but pinned separately*

**9. Saddlebreds** – partbred, 3 years & under.

**10. Saddlebreds** – partbred, 4 years & over.

**11. Saddlebreds** – partbred, British Bred

*Classes 12 – 16 open to Pure or partbreds.*

**12. Foreign Breeds** – 3yrs & under.

**13. Foreign Breeds** – 4yrs & over, Mares.

**14. Foreign Breeds** – 4yrs & over, Geldings.

**15. Foreign Breeds** – 4yrs & over, Stallions.

**C1 Purebred Saddlebred, C2 Partbred Saddlebred & C3 Morgan Championship**

*Top 3 from classes 4 – 6 & 9 – 11, IF also USA-UK (or ASHA) registered and owned/shown by USA-UK members. C3: for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> classes 1 – 3. C1, C2 & C3 Judged together, pinned separately.*

**16. Skewbalds & Piebalds**, any age or sex.

**C4 Grand In Hand Championship** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 1 – 16. Additional Award for Best Youngstock (3yrs & under).

##### **30 minute BREAK**

**Hunter Pleasure** – traditional English tack, snaffle, Pelham or double bridle (**similar to Riding Horse, Show Hunter or Show Cob classes**). To be shown at walk, trot (working), medium / extended trot, canter and hand gallop.

#### **RIDDEN CLASSES**

**17. Baby Green** – First year of showing under saddle or not to have won a ridden class. Any breed or tack, including training. Walk & trot only.

**18. Limit Hunter** Any breed, not to have won more than 6 hunter pleasure classes.

**19. Novice Spanish & Lusitano** English tack, snaffle bridle, not to have won more than 2 ridden Spanish / Lusitano or Iberian classes. Pure or partbred.

*Classes 20 & 21 may be judged together but pinned separately*

**20. Saddlebred Hunter Pleasure**

**21. Morgan Hunter Pleasure**

**22. Ridden Skewbald & Piebald** English tack, any breed.

**23. Amateur Rider Hunter Pleasure**

Any breed

**24. Open Spanish & Lusitano** English tack, may include all movements. Pure or partbred.

*Short show required.*

**25. Road Hack.** Hunt seat or saddle seat, any breed. To be shown at walk, trot, extended trot, canter & hand gallop & to halt on the rail & walk off on a loose rein.

**26. Appaloosa Hunter Pleasure**

**27. Open Hunter Pleasure** Any breed.

**C5 Hunter Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 18 – 24, 26, 27 & the highest placed hunt seat horse from class 25.

##### **BREAK**

**Class 28 will NOT start before 1pm, but may start later, depending on entries.**

**28. Concour's D'Elegance** In hand or ridden, walk only, period, heritage or traditional dress – judged purely on turnout. Any breed.

**29. Spanish & Lusitano Parade** Spanish or Portuguese tack, pure or partbred. Come and strut your stuff – emulate the atmosphere of the Golega Fair where horses parade for the audience, giving you the chance to show off your horse in the most entertaining way. Enter on left rein.

**30. Paso Fino Pleasure** Horse should be a pleasure to ride, calm & responsive and gaits should be performed evenly & consistently.

**C6 Spanish & Lusitano Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 19, 24 & 29.

**31. Paso Fino Youth Pleasure** Similar to class 30, but open to youth riders only.

#### **WESTERN CLASSES**

Western horses may be shown 2 handed in a snaffle/hackamore/bosal or 1 handed in a curb bit. To be shown at walk, jog and lope. Extended jog and extended lope can be asked for in the Amateur and Open classes.

**32. Limit Western Pleasure**

Not to have won more than 6 classes in western pleasure. Any breed.

**33. Saddlebred & Morgan Western Pleasure**

**34. Paso Fino 3-Gaits** To be shown in walk, cortol largo and canter.

*Classes 35 & 36, open to any breed and may be judged together but pinned separately*

**35. Amateur Rider Western Pleasure**

**36. Open Western Pleasure**

**37. Paso Fino Performance**

Like Pleasure (class 30), but horse to show more spirit & collection in the execution of his gaits.

**38. Western Horsemanship** Any breed, pattern to be ridden first and then top horses to show back on the rail at walk, jog & lope.

**39. Saddlebred 5-Gaited Pleasure**

**40. Paso Fino Youth Performance** Like class 37, but open to youth riders only

**40B. Limit Saddle Seat Pleasure**

Any breed, classic, pleasure or park.

**C7 Western Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 32, 33, 35 & 36.

##### **BREAK**

**41. Saddlebred & Morgan Park Saddle** (Saddle seat) shown at park walk, park trot & canter. Pads & weights allowed.

*Classes 42 & 43 may be judged together but pinned separately.* Entries should be plain shod (no pads) & shown by amateurs only. Shown at flat walk, trot, extended trot & canter.

**42. Morgan Classic Pleasure Saddle**

**43. Saddlebred 3G Country Pleasure**

**44. Morgan Pleasure Saddle.**

**45. Saddlebred 3-Gaited Pleasure** Shown at flat or animated walk, trot & canter.

**46. Paso Fino Natural Gaiters** Will be asked to gait on a loose rein to demonstrate a natural gait. *Classes 47 & 48 open to any breed and may be judged together but pinned separately.*

**47. Amateur Rider Saddle Seat Pleasure.**

**48. Open Saddle Seat Pleasure**

**49. Classic Fino**

**C8 Saddlebred European Ridden**

**Championship** Open to all Saddlebreds who have been placed in classes 20, 33, 39, 41 & 45, IF also USA-UK (or ASHA) registered and owned/shown by USA-UK members.

**C9 Paso Fino Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 30, 31, 34, 37, 40, 46 & 49.

**C10 Saddle Seat Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 40B & 41– 45, 47, 48 & highest placed saddle seat horse from class 25.

**C11 Amateur Rider Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 23, 31, 35, 40, 42, 43 & 47.

**C12 Grand Saddle Championship.** All Champions & Reserves from C5 to C11.

#### **PLEASE READ**

**Morgans:** Top 4 horses from each Morgan class qualify for the **AMHA Morgan Grand Nationals** in October. Morgan classes open to purebreds only.

**Saddlebreds:** Points from this show count towards qualification at the **Kentucky State Fair World Championship Horse Show** in August. Ridden Saddlebred classes open to both pure & partbreds. Purebreds in classes 2 – 4 must be ASHA or USA-UK registered. Additional rosettes will be presented to the highest placed Saddlebred in C5, C7, C9, C10, C11 & C12. **Rugs to all champions in C1, C2 and C8 – to be eligible for these championships Saddlebreds must be USA-UK or ASHA registered and owned/shown by USA-UK members.**

**Spanish/Portuguese Horses:** Horses entering the in hand section of this show wearing a serreta must have a throat latch.

**Skewbalds & Piebalds:** Top 3 horses in classes 16 & 22 qualifier for **BSPA World Championship of Colour** this August. Stallions 4 years & over must be BSPA registered, licensed and graded in order to compete in these 2 classes.

**ALL ENTRIES to enter on the left rein at TROT (jog or cortol), including in hand, except Baby Green, Concour's D'Elegance & Western Horsemanship - enter at walk. No individual show required, except class 24. The judge will not ride in any class. In hand horses to trot to end of first rail and line up nose to tail. You will**

then be pulled forward for individual inspection. **Ridden classes** will ask for walk, trot / jog and canter / lope (and maybe more depending on the class), reverse (change the rein) and then the same on the right rein. Rein back is usually asked in the line up in pleasure classes. **Allow 5-10 minutes per class – please arrive earlier rather than later so as not to miss your class. Please be ready in the warm-up ring one class before you are due to show, to assist the Gate Steward.**

Most classes are **qualifiers** for **Royal London Show** (restrictions apply) – see website for more details. Cards will be available at the Secretary's Desk on the day – please remember to collect them before you go home. The covered outdoor arena has been booked all day and is to be used as a warm up area after the sport horse classes have finished (approx. 11.30am). Please do not use other areas. Please park cars, trailers and lorries considerately. Stabling is available on site and should be booked directly with the college – see separate entry form. Advertising is available in the show programme – copy deadline 1 month prior to the show. This event has been organised for USA-UK by a selected committee. Neither the committee, USA-UK or its representatives, or the owners and staff of Warwickshire College accept any responsibility for any loss, theft or damage whatsoever to any animal, item or article associated with the show or for any accident or injury to any item, person or animal howsoever caused. Competitors and owners shall be bound by the rules of the venue, USA-UK judging standards and show rules (2009) – these can be viewed online at: [www.american-saddlebred.co.uk](http://www.american-saddlebred.co.uk) All competitors must have adequate insurance to cover any incident that may be caused by them or their animals. Although every effort will be made to adhere to the printed schedule, the organisers reserve the right to combine, cancel or change the running order of classes on the day if the needs arise and to refuse entry without specifying the reason. The United Saddlebred Association would like to extend a big thank you to everyone involved with the organisation and running of this show.

**Saddlebreds:** Indication of participation in the 2011 European Charter Club Challenge classes **MUST** be made in advance on the entry form. These classes will run concurrently with the Saddlebred classes at this show.

**Allow 5-10 minutes per class. Sport Horse classes start at 8.30am – entry will be via the gate that borders the car park, In Hand classes start at 9am – all classes follow on – to aid the gate steward you should be ready in the collecting ring one class early.**
