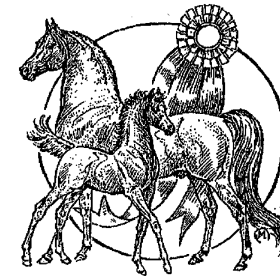

Performance classes open to both pure and partbred Saddlebreds. **All Saddlebreds** – owners or riders need not be members of any society to compete in a class, but must be USA-UK members to compete in any of the championships. USA-UK highest placed members' rosettes will be awarded at this show. In the event of any dispute the BMHS Board's decision is final All competitors must undertake to be familiar with BMHS Judging Standards (Morgans) and Show Rules (2006 Version) (all horses).
