- 1 Pure bred mares three years and over
- 2 Pure bred geldings three years and over
- 3 Pure bred stallions three years and over (adult handler only)
- 4 Pure bred hunter/sport horse type any age (no cross entering with classes 1, 2, 3, 5)
- 5 Pure bred yearlings and two year olds
- 6 Pure bred veterans all sexes 15 years and over
- 7 Part breeds all ages

In Hand Championship - Alan Tabelin Memorial Salver

- 8 Handling class - open. Any horse, handler only to be judged
- 9 Handling class - youth. Any horse, handler only to be judged

- 10. Best turned out. Any tack or attire. Walk trot only
- 11. "Baby Green" ridden class. Any seat, tack or attire. Walk trot only. Training tack allowed but must be smart. First year of showing only
- 12. Pleasure saddle. No cross entering with 13
- 13. Classic pleasure saddle. No cross entering with 12
- 14. Youth leadline equitation, any tack or attire, walk trot only. No cross entering with 15 or 16.
- 15. Youth walk/trot equitation. Any seat. No cross entering with 14 or 16
- 16. Equitation. Any seat. Any age of rider. No pattern. Separate youth ribbons. No cross entering with 14 or 15
- 17. Park saddle
- 18. Pleasure harness

19. Classic and 'laid back' harness (any harness and vehicle). No cross entering with 18. Separate rosettes for classic and laid back

20. Park harness

21. Road hack (Championship Show qualifier - top 6)

22. Hunter pleasure

23. Potential sport horse. Three small fences. Judged on athleticism and scope

24. Amateur pleasure saddle. Hunt and saddleseat judged together, pinned separately

25. Western pleasure

Short break. Assistance welcomed to build trail course

26. In hand trail class

27. Ridden trail class

Hi Points Championship Award

This is decided on points. A horse must enter at least three of classes

10 - 27 to qualify (excl 14, 15, 16, 26 and 27)
