- 1 Pure bred mares three years and over
- 2 Pure bred geldings three years and over
- 3 Pure bred stallions three years and over (adult handler only)
- 4 Pure bred hunter/sport horse type any age (no cross entering with classes 1, 2, 3, 5)
- 5 Pure bred yearlings and two year olds
- 6 Pure bred veterans any type 15 years and over
- 7 Part bred all ages

### **In Hand Championship - Trophy**

- 8 Handling class - open. Any horse, handler only to be judged
- 9 Handling class - youth. Any horse, handler only to be judged
- 10 Fancy dress class. Walk trot only. Special prizes!

### **Lunch break. Lunch available £5 - pre orders only on entry form**

- 11. Best turned out. Any tack or attire. Walk trot only
- 12. "Baby Green" ridden class. Any seat, tack or attire. Walk trot only. Training tack allowed but must be smart. First year of ridden showing only
- 13. Pleasure saddle. No cross entering with 14
- 14. Classic pleasure saddle. No cross entering with 13
- 15. Youth leadline equitation, any tack or attire, walk trot only. No cross entering with 16 or 17.
- 16. Youth walk/trot equitation. Any seat. No cross entering with 15 or 17
- 17. Equitation. Any seat. Any age of rider. No pattern. Separate youth ribbons. No cross entering with 15 or 16
- 18. Park saddle
- 19. Pleasure harness

20. Classic and 'laid back' harness (any harness and vehicle). No cross entering with 19. Separate rosettes for classic and laid back

21. Park harness

22. Road hack (Championship Show qualifier - top 6)

23. Hunter pleasure

24. Sport horse. Judged on the rail and over fences, emphasis on athleticism and scope.

25. Amateur pleasure saddle. Hunt and saddleseat judged together, pinned separately

26. Western pleasure

28. Ridden trail class

### **Hi Points Championship Award**

This is decided on points. A horse must enter at least three of classes

11 - 28 to qualify (excl 15, 16, 17, 27 and 28)
