- 1 Purebred Mares three years and over
- 2. Purebred Geldings three years and over
- 3. Purebred Stallions three years and over (adult handler only)
- 4. Purebred Hunter/sport horse type any age(no cross entering with classes 1, 2, 3, 5)
- 5. Purebred Yearlings and two year olds
- 6. Veterans 15 years and over Any breed any sex
- 7. World Breed Pure & Part Breeds

IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP -

- 8. Baby Green ridden class. Any seat/tack/attire. Walk trot. Training tack allowed but must be smart. First year of ridden showing, not to have won any other ridden class before today Any Breed

- 9. Best Turned Out. Any tack/attire. Walk Trot Only: Any Breed
- 10. Nervous/Novice Rider, any seat/ tack/attire. Walk trot. Not to have won this or any other ridden class previously : Any Breed
- 11. Novice horse, any seat walk trot canter, training tack allowed. Not to have won a Novice/Open class before. Any Breed
- 12. Park/Pleasure Saddle. Pinned separately. No cross entering with 14.
- 13. Youth Leadline Equitation & youth walk/trot equitation. Judged together, pinned separately: Any Breed
- 14. Classic Pleasure Saddle. No cross entering with 12
- 15. World Breed Ridden class any Seat, traditional dress allowed
- 16. Youth Equitation, riders under 21, walk, trot, canter, any seat, any breed. No pattern
- 17. Pleasure Harness./Park Harness pinned separately No cross entering with 20
- 18. Hunter Pleasure
- 19. Road Hack
- 20. Classic/ Laid Back Harness (any harness and vehicle). No cross entering with 17.
- 21. Ridden Veteran 15 years and over, any seat : Any Breed
- 22. Amateur Pleasure Saddle. Any Seat. Any Breed

Short Break

23 Veteran In Hand and Ridden Championship - open to 1st - 4th from classes 6 and 21. Golden Ticket to In Hand Champ and Reserve and Saddle Champ and Reserve

24 GRAND PERFORMANCE CHAMPION - open to first and second from classes 12, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22.

- Classes will be combined if fewer than two entries.
- **CURRENT EQUINE 'Flu' VACCINATION certificates are required** for all horses entered and failure to produce on demand could mean expulsion from the college premises
- **Horse Passports must be carried**
- Breaks for tack changes must be notified
- Withdrawals must be notified
- Substitutions are permitted
- The Two Minute Gate Rule will be applied
- BS or PAS hats must be worn in all jumping classes and by all youth members. **THE BMHS STRONGLY RECOMMENDS THAT ALL RIDERS WEAR PAS 015 RIDING HATS, CORRECTLY FITTED AND FASTENED. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY INVALIDATE INSURANCE COVER AND IS ENTIRELY AT THE RIDER'S RISK. YOUTH MEMBERS MUST WEAR THE SPECIFIED STANDARD OF HARD HAT AT ALL TIMES WHEN RIDING, DRIVING OR IN HAND**

- Refunds can only be considered upon production of a valid vet's certificate
- The judge's decision is FINAL
- Please keep dogs under control at all times

- If camping in a tent please ensure it is pitched out of the way from vehicles.

THE GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION 2018 (GDPR) NOTICE

GENERAL

The BMHS is a data controller registered with the Information Commissioner and endeavours at all times to process your personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation 2018 (GDPR). Your personal details will be kept confidential and secure and, as part of your membership contract, will be processed by BMHS for the following purposes:

- Administration of your membership of BMHS.
- Contacting you about BMHS activities.
- Statistical and analytical purposes.
- Providing details of Panel Judges to affiliated shows.
- Supplying information to DEFRA.

The BMHS will not disclose your personal data to third part data controllers other than in connection with the DEFRA passport legislation, unless in accordance with law or with your permission.

The BMHS will continue to process your personal data as part of it's ongoing horse breeding database, until you notify the BMHS to stop processing your personal data.

Information supplied in connection with your membership application or horse registration will be passed by the BMHS to DEFRA in order to provide a source of data that supports veterinary disease control and surveillance activities.

- to discharge its responsibilities for implementation of horse passports.
- to facilitate strategic planning within the Equine Sector.
- to assist in tracing the owners of straying, lost or stolen horses; and
- to reduce malpractice in the sale of horses and ponies.

The horse passport base information may, in future, be used for research purposes or statistical analysis by educational and commercial organisations. Your personal data may be shared, if necessary, within the DEFRA family, with other Central Government Departments and with Non-Departmental Public Bodies and with Local Authorities. They are required by law to keep your personal data confidential and secure at all times. Data may be processed by a contracted third party on their behalf: that party will also be required to keep all data secure.

In certain, limited circumstances, DEFRA or its agents may be required to release information, including personal data, on request under the Environmental Information Regulations, the Code of Practice on Access to Government Information or the Freedom of Information Act 2000. However, neither DEFRA nor its agents will permit any unwarranted breach of confidentiality nor with the BMHS act in contravention of its obligations under the General Data Protection Regulation 2018 (GDPR).
