41 Ridden Paso Fino Pure or partbred, any saddle. To be shown at walk, corto & canter largo.

FOREIGN & SADDLE SEAT CHAMPIONSHIP (Fr) - for 1st & 2nd from 33 – 37, 39 & 41, plus HP saddle seat in 38, 40, 55 & 56. (The Sparks Plate).

RING 3 - IN HAND (9.30am)

THE SMALL PRINT!

Unless otherwise specified, all classes are open to any breed horse / pony, any age, any height. Hunt Seat (h/s) - traditional English style of showing, with forward seat. Saddle Seat - traditional American style of showing, with Lane Fox style saddle and double bridle. Individual ridden shows are not normally required. Stallions and colts welcome, but should be bitted and under control and to be shown by adults. Horses should be turned out correct for their breed (with full mane & tail if correct), in all classes. Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place, plus specials. All Trophies are Perpetual Challenge (where sponsored - shown in brackets - a deposit may be asked) must be signed for at the Secretary's desk before they will be presented and are to be returned by 1st July 2008, unless winners have pre-entered the 2008 show by this date. (Please indicate on your entry form the names of any trophies that you are returning on the day of the show). BHS Approved Safety Hats MUST be worn at all times when mounted. Junior exhibitors (under 18) MUST wear BHS hats in ALL classes. Adult riders should ensure that the Secretary is in possession of a Disclaimer Form (see entry form) for any non-safety conforming traditional headgear. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses in connection with or arising out of the show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Promoters against any legal action arising out of any incident and to agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the show and PEC. All competitors must have adequate insurance to cover any incident that may be caused by them or their animals. The organisers reserve the right to combine, cancel or change the running order of classes on the day if the needs arise. The APHS would like to thank all the sponsors, Judges, stewards and helpers that run the show. If you enjoyed the show tell your friends, if you didn't tell the Organisers!

SKEWBALDS & PIEBALDS (classes 1 – 8, 60 – 63): these classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald & Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the World Championships of Colour National Champions of Champions 2008. Champion & reserve from both In Hand and Ridden Coloured Championships will qualify for The Star Championship at WCoC. All classes will be judged within the rules and criteria of the BSPA. ALL stallions 4 years and over MUST be graded, registered and licensed with the BSPA. All owners/handlers/riders MUST be BSPA members and horses/ponies registered with BSPA prior to the show in order to qualify. Competitors must produce their BSPA Qualification Card in the ring for the Judge to sign, otherwise qualification is invalid. Non-registered horses (except stallions, see previous) and/or those owned by non-members MAY compete in any class, but obviously will not be eligible for qualification. SADDLEBREDS – must be USA-UK registered to compete in classes 31, 32 & 35. **IBERIAN / USA-UK members** – rosettes will be awarded to the HP Iberian & the HP ASB (shown by USA-UK members) in classes 27, 29, 33, 37 & 40 (plus 31, 32, 34, 35, 38, 39, 56, 57, 61 & 62 for ASBs). **MORGANS** – the top 6 Morgans in class 42 qualify for the BMHS 2008 European Road Hack Championships. **Ridden FOREIGN** breeds open to both pure and partbreds (min 25%) **CHAMPIONSHIPS** – if you do not intend to show back, please let the Secretary know ASAP on the day.
